Today is the last day of this half term and we have some important information to share with you all for the next half term. The next term will start Monday 20th February 2017.

NEW CHANGE: Attendance and Punctuality (Lateness)

As we all know excellent attendance and punctuality is the key to success. We at Al-Muntada School try our utmost to ensure that attendance and punctuality are the highest they possibly can be in order to prepare our pupils for future adult life.

We are very concerned about the punctuality of some pupils at our school. Pupils who arrive late have been missing our daily Du'a sessions and very important assemblies which are part of our Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural curriculum. All pupils who have been attending regularly and are punctual have benefited greatly from these assemblies.

Latecomers to school have been causing disruption and disturbance during assembly time. We have tried our utmost to accommodate these latecomers and reminded such parents on many occasions to be on time but sadly our reminders sometimes have fallen on deaf ears.

As you know that children should be in school at 8:00am. The school gates open at 7:45am. This means parents have plenty of time to drop their children early. Our **new policy** to tackle this persistent lateness and reduce any further disruption and disturbance to assembly time, the school gates will be to close at 8:15am. The school playground door will only be re-open after assembly. This new policy will be implemented as from 20th February (after half term).

We would like to emphasise that pupils who do not attend the morning assemblies will automatically be marked late. For your information, the school is required to report persistent lateness to the Local Authority.

Collecting pupils for booster class (Year 6)

This is to let you know that the booster classes finish at 5pm and pupils can no longer be collected from the school gates but rather the Masjid entrance into the school (7 bridges place Fulham sw6 4hw). The doors on the 1st floor will open at 5pm so that parents do not need to wait outside the school gate in this cold weather. Parking is free on the street at 5pm. **NO PARKING IS PERMITTED AT THE FRONT OF THE MASJID.**
