The blessed month of Ramadhan is upon us and hence we will be closing our school an hour earlier than the normal timetable at **2:20pm**. As a reminder these days are in lieu of our shorter Easter, Christmas and Summer half term break. We have re-arranged the timings of our timetable to give a fair coverage to all the curriculum areas.

The school will be closed for the last 12 days of Ramadhan including Eid, from 12th- 26th June. On Friday 30th June there will be an Eid party for all our children.
