AREAS OF DEVELOPMENT	WHAT WE WILL BE LEARNING	HOW YOU CAN HELP
PSED	Learning about boundaries and rules, learning to take turns, respecting and learning to be fair, understanding differences.	Make sure children know what the boundaries are at school and at home, be consistent in following up boundaries. Always remind children and demonstrate to them the importance of respecting others. Read books and look at stories to encourage children.
PD	Holding writing tool such as pencil using tripod grip. Attending to own needs such as washing and dressing up.	Use writing tools using tripod grip, demonstrate and encourage them. Always encourage children to do things for themselves such as feeding, dressing even helping to clean and tidy at home, this is very important for their development.
CL	Listening to others and stories, understand simple instructions, rhymes to develop language. Understanding to take turns not over talk others.	Read to your child different stories and ask them questions to check their understanding, give them simple instructions to follow, go through different rhymes to develop language and encourage children to use variety of words.
LITERACY	Learning to handle books turning pages appropriately, look at picture books and books with texts, learn the letter sounds and begin to read simple words.	Take your child to library as often as you can and encourage them to re tell stories by looking at pictures and blending familiar letter sounds.
MATHEMATICS	Counting up to 10/20 and recognize most numbers up to 10. Identifying how many objects are in a set. Matching numerals and quantities correctly. Comparing groups of objects. Recognizing simple shapes.	Go through counting rhymes with your child even during day to day tasks encourage them to count and recognize numbers, recognize shapes around the environment.
UW	Talking about family and friends, significant events in their life and learning about different occupations in life. Weather and seasons, days of week and months.	Encourage your child to remember and talk about important events that happened in their life about family learning who and how people are related to them e.g



		<p> aunty, maternal aunty etc.  Encourage your child to learn about a variety of occupations and not just the usual ones e.g doctors, take them for walks and educate them about the different professions available.  Sing along to songs to help them remember the days of the week, months and seasons.</p>
EAD	<p> Learning names of colours, using colours appropriately, how colours can be changed, and exploring different textures. Learning different rhymes and engaging in role play.</p>	<p> Repeat names of colours to children and extend learning by encouraging them to learn more names of colours. Get children to feel different textures like flour etc.</p>
